Welcome to today's service!

Every so often I find myself shouting at my children, "Enough! Will you please be quiet!" One of the family usually gives me a slightly quizzical look at that point. It's a quick way to look stupid, to hold others to standards that you don't live up to yourself, and if you do it often enough, it makes you pretty unpopular. As we come to the conclusion of this famous bit of teaching, the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus returns to consider in more detail the dangers of an attitude of self-righteousness, which we learnt about last week. The danger of an attitude of self-righteousness is that it leads to hypocrisy. In its place, Jesus shows us a better way: a life of integrity and grace. But it's not going to be easy to live like this.
