# **Ruth—Little Story, Big love: Disaster strikes Ruth**

"With her two daughters-in-law she left the place where she had been living and set out on the road that would take them back to the land of Judah.' Ruth 1:7

# **Welcome to today's service!**

Where is God when it hurts to be alive? Sometimes life events knock us flat, and, from the sunlit uplands, we find ourselves spiralling down, anxious and helpless. Loss - of a job, a relationship, a familiar environment or through bereavement - exposes who we are and the reliability of what, or who, we trust in.

As a Jewish economic migrant, Naomi has accommodated herself within a new culture, yet gradually everything starts to go wrong. This Sunday we join her at the point of disaster and walk with her as she finds a way through. It is the lowest point in the book of Ruth, which we're studying over the coming weeks, the valley which must be negotiated before the path returns to the light.

Like Naomi, there are times when we need to hold on to the truth that, however submerged we feel, 'The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. (John 1:5)

We love having families of all ages in our 10.45am service. All children and youth are welcome to join our groups: Sparklers (under 3s), Ignite (3-5 years), One Way (6-11 years) and Ablaze (youth aged 11-16 years).
