Immersion Baptism

Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. For we were all baptised by one Spirit so as to form one body. (1 Corinthians 12:12-13a)

Welcome to today's service!

Today is a really special day. Five candidates will be getting baptised and or re-affirming their baptism. It's a day of celebration and worship as we witness five people, sharing their story and publicly announcing their faith to God and the whole Church.

It also gives us the opportunity to re-think our own baptism, and to question our own faith. Whether we've been a Christian for years, or whether we've just started to explore faith, the call to baptism is the most significant call we can receive from God. It is a call to participate in Jesus Christ's death and resurrection. We spiritually die to our old selves, our old life absent from following Jesus as we are submerged in the water. And we respond to Jesus' grace as we rise up out of the water as Christ rose from the grave giving us a whole new life.

This is where we find our identity as loved children of God, called to follow his ways with an eternal perspective. Today we celebrate the fact that baptism brings us into God's family, we become the Church through that beautiful gift of water and the spirit, where we are called to serve God, through serving one another and working together for God's mission, praise and Glory.
