Word Read 2 Corinthians 8.1-15

Read 1 Corinthians 16.1-4 and Romans 15.25-27 (written either during or shortly after Paul had revisited Corinth)

1. What is this collection all about?
2. What do you learn about the Macedonians from their giving, cf v1,2,3?
3. In the light of the struggles in Corinth, why would Paul draw their attention to the Macedonian example?
4. What would this test of their generosity reveal, v8?
5. What principles about giving do you observe in this passage?

For discussion

1. If you were to evaluate your zeal for God in the light of your bank statement (or your cheque book) what would it tell you about your faith or love for God? (Be as open as you can be)
2. What, from Jesus' example, prompts you to be generous with your money, time and energy, v9?
3. What inhibits you from being generous?
