Word Read Hebrews 10.19-25

1. What is the significance of Jesus' blood in giving us the confidence to enter into the presence of God, and what is your reaction to the depths and length that Jesus went to for us?
2. We're told in verse 20 that a 'new living way has been opened up for us'. What might this mean practically for you in your life?
3. Based on Christ's sacrifice (v19-20) and priesthood (v21), what attitudes and actions follow? Note the four 'let us' statements in v22-25. What does each one mean? What incentives are given?

4. In verse 23 we are told to hold on unswervingly to the hope we profess. How might you sum the hope you have in Jesus?

Witness Reflecting on verses 24 and 25, in what ways do you think the Church has been spurring each other on, these last couple of months? Looking ahead, how could we do this better, or more meaningfully?
