What were their feelings as a result of Jesus' actions?

How did this event change the disciples' perception of Jesus?

On "the other side of the cross", how does our knowledge and experience of Jesus affect the way we feel and behave in a threatening situation?

In what practical ways can we draw on the love and strength of Jesus when we feel helpless or overwhelmed?

Prompt:

1. Keep our eyes on Jesus.
2. Bring everything to the Father in prayer. (Pray in the gap)
3. Choose to copy Jesus in our behaviour and actions, and point to Him.

Supplementary question:

How do we feel about God letting this coronavirus pandemic happen?
